PREACHING PRINCIPLES

This past week I read a preacher-focused article that is "Biblical, Personal and Practical. The topic was the essentiality of presenting God's Word to others only after self-application.

BIBLICAL: Paul wrote precisely what he felt and practiced and in the very words of inspiration from the Holy Spirit; "I discipline myself so that after I have preached others, I myself should not be disqualified!" (I Corinthians 9:27) Jesus himself said, "I only speak what my Father in heaven tells me to speak." (John 12:49) It is essential that a preacher preaches God's Truth because in so doing we are building upon the only firm foundation and anything other than gospel truth is fake and false- regardless! Precisely why I mostly practice "textual" rather than "topical" preaching. One of my cherished Bible professors often emphasized that "it is the best way to expose the Bible."

PERSONAL: The article emphasized that a preacher should be so personally involved in the text that he cannot wait to present it to the church. He must be engulfed in the meaning of the text, so excited by being personally involved and so committed to sharing it that it easily flows from him to every member! It must be heartfelt in order to enter hearts! No one has the right to make the Bible boring! Amen!

PRACTICAL: Information without Application is Stagnation! We must certainly "sing them over again" but if we engage our spiritual engines into "parking gear" we become idle when there are souls to reach and teach. It is so easy to merely invite someone to church as a first step in "doing" what Jesus came to do - soul focus!

Thank you, dad, I love you and these specific preaching principles continue to echo within me!
