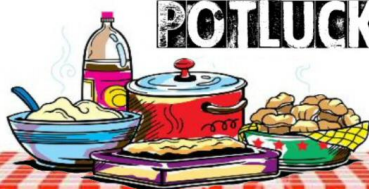

### **Godly Parenting – Part 4**

# **“Anger is Contagious”**

Did you know emotions are contagious? If anger fills the home, children begin to think anger is normal. If yelling becomes the everyday response, they often grow up believing that is how problems are solved. But if grace, patience and calm fill the home, they will learn those too.

That’s why James 1:19-20 tell us:

*“Be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to become angry, because human anger does not produce the righteousness God desires.”*

Notice James doesn’t just tell us to control our words—he tells us to control our hearts.

As parents, our homes should be a refuge, not a storm. Our children should feel safe coming to us, not afraid of how we will react.

Emotional self-control is not weakness. It is spiritual leadership. The strongest parent in the room is not the loudest one. It is the one who, through God’s help, chooses patience over anger and wisdom over reaction.

**Challenge Question:**

When my children – or those around me – experience me, do they experience the peace of Christ. . .or the pressure of my frustration?



**“Lord, rule my heart so anger doesn’t rule my home. Help me to reflect the patience and love of Christ in both my words and my actions. Amen.”**
