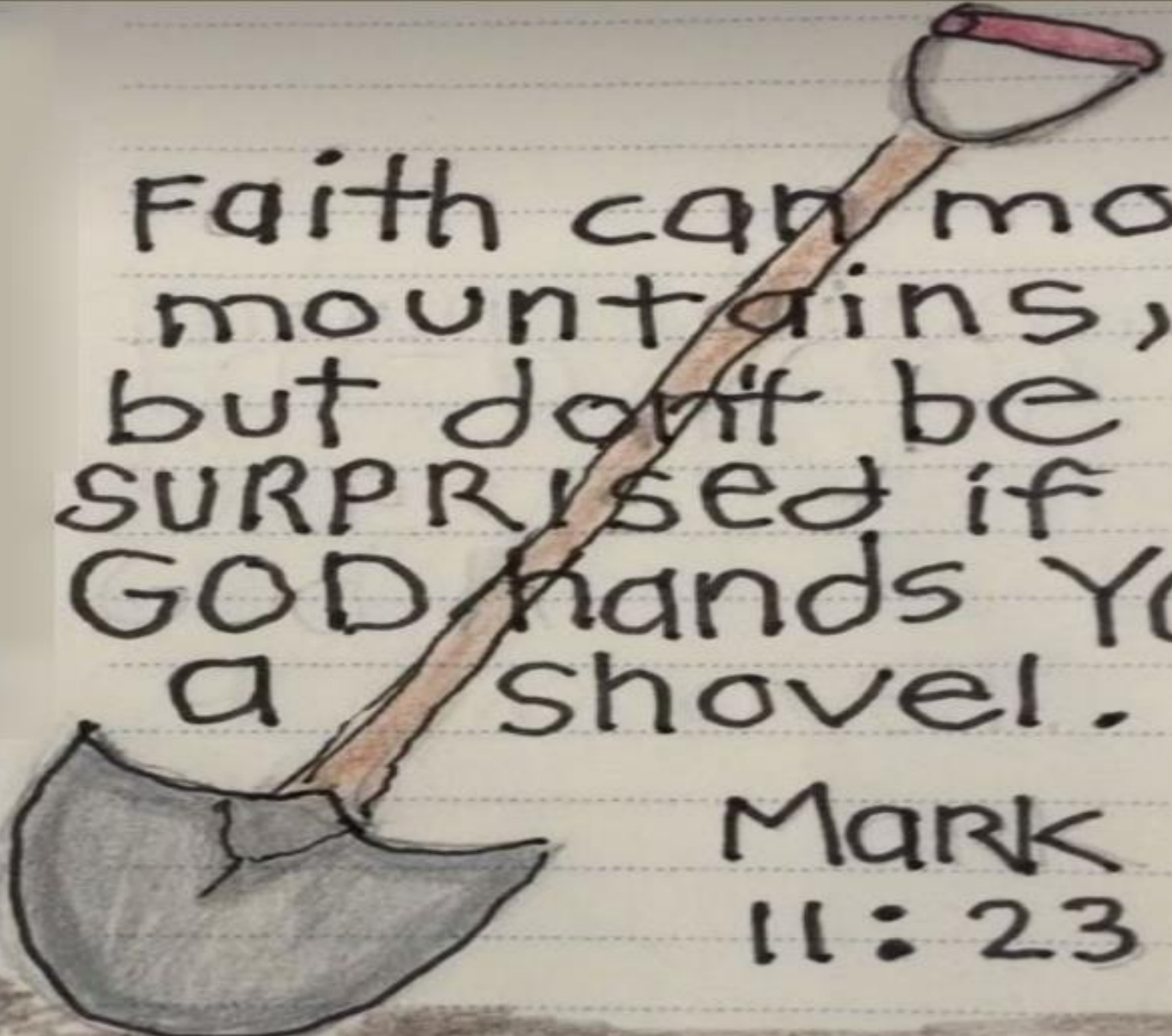

DISCIPLINE vs PUNISHMENT

Have you ever stopped and asked yourself, “Am I correcting . . .or just reacting?”

There is a big difference between punishment and discipline. Punishment often comes from frustration. It focuses on the mistake.

Discipline comes from love. It focuses on the person and their growth. That is exactly how God deals with us.

Hebrews 12:11 says, *“All discipline for the moment seems not to be joyful, but sorrowful; yet to those who have been trained by it, afterward it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness.”*

God doesn’t discipline us to tear us down. He disciplines us to build us up. His goal is not revenge—it is righteousness. The same should be true for us.

Whether you are a parent, grandparent, teacher, coach, or simply encouraging another Christian, do not let anger be your motivation. Let love be your guide.

Correct to teach.

Correct to restore.

Correct to help someone become more like Christ.

The next time you need to correct someone, ask yourself: *“Am I trying to release my frustration, or am I trying to shape their character?”*

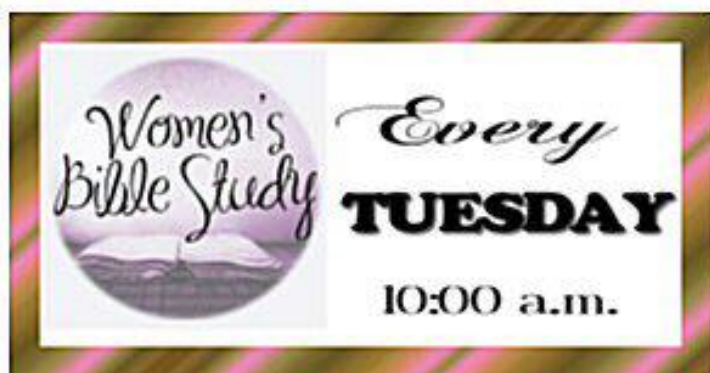

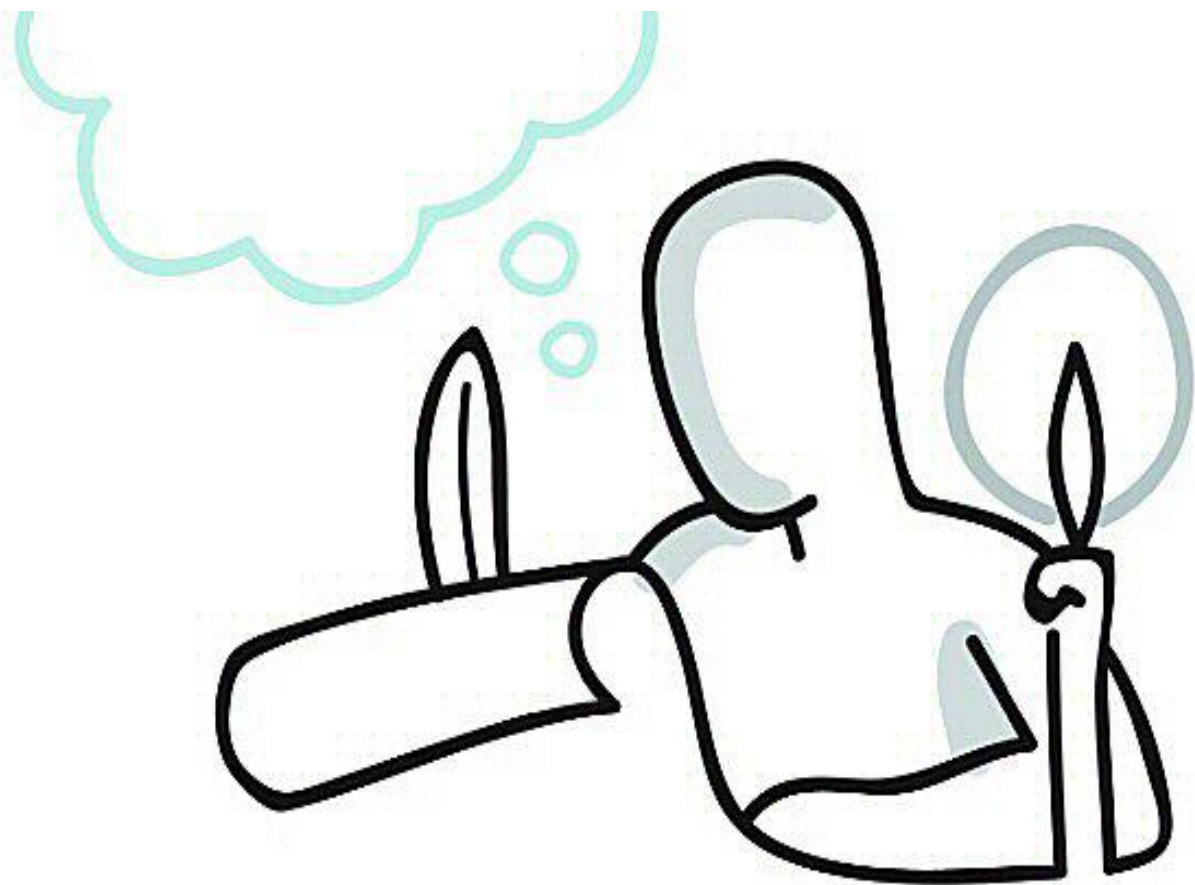
