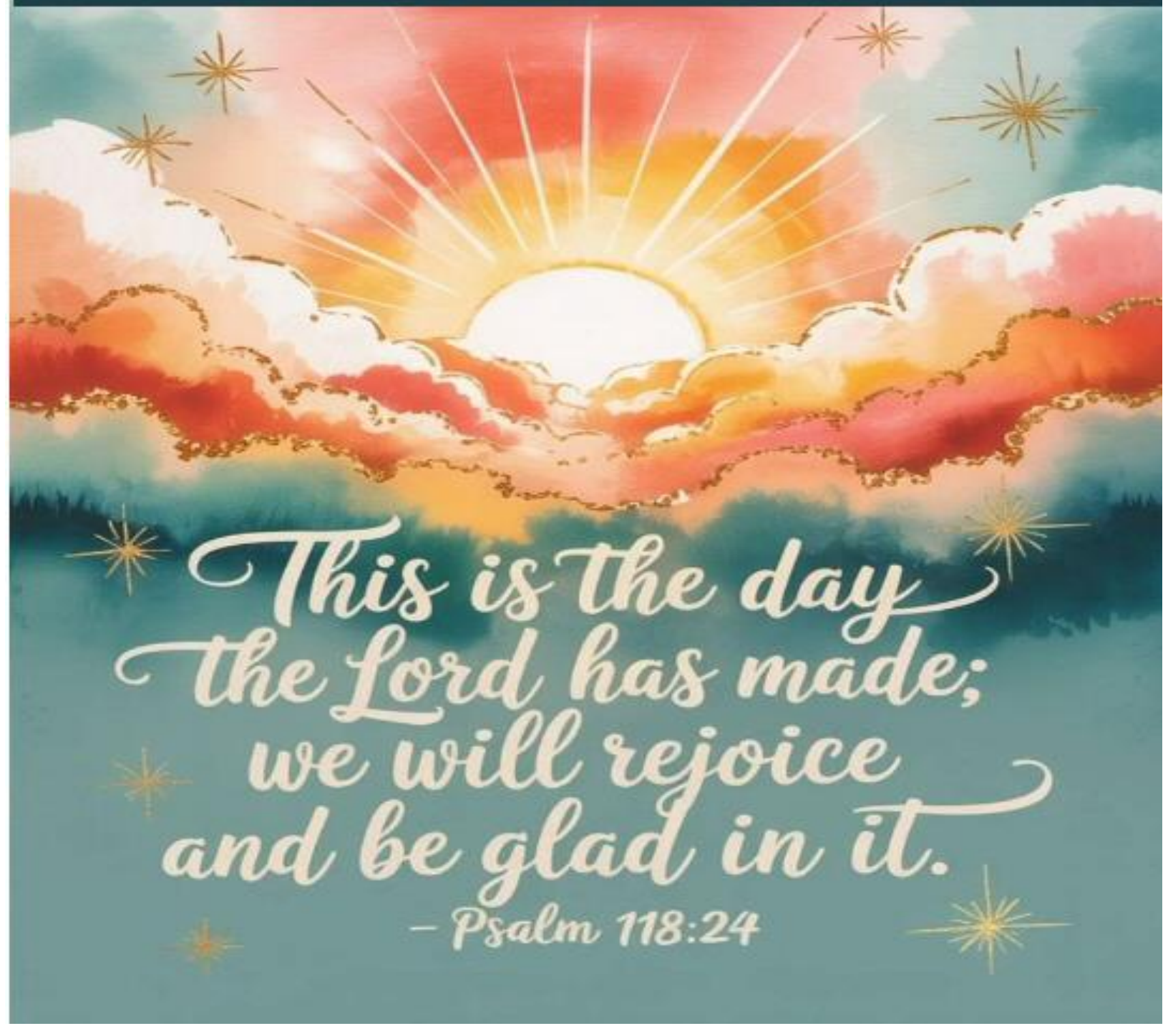

Godly Communication No. 1 – Listen First

“Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.” – James 1:19

Good communication does not begin with speaking—it begins with listening.

That’s the order God gives us in James 1:19. Before we are told to speak, we are told to listen. Why? Because listening shows respect. It communicates, *“You matter, and I want to understand you.”*

Too often, we are thinking about our next response instead of hearing what the other person is saying. When we do that, we may hear the words but miss the heart behind them.

Jesus listened to people. He took time to hear their hurts, questions, and struggles before offering truth and hope. If we want to communicate like Christ, we must first learn to listen like Christ.

This week, slow down. Give someone your full attention. You may discover that your willingness to listen speaks louder than your words ever could.

Challenge: *Am I listening to understand, or simply waiting to respond?*



Prayer: *Father, help me be quick to listen, slow to speak, and filled with Your love in every conversation. In Jesus name, Amen.*

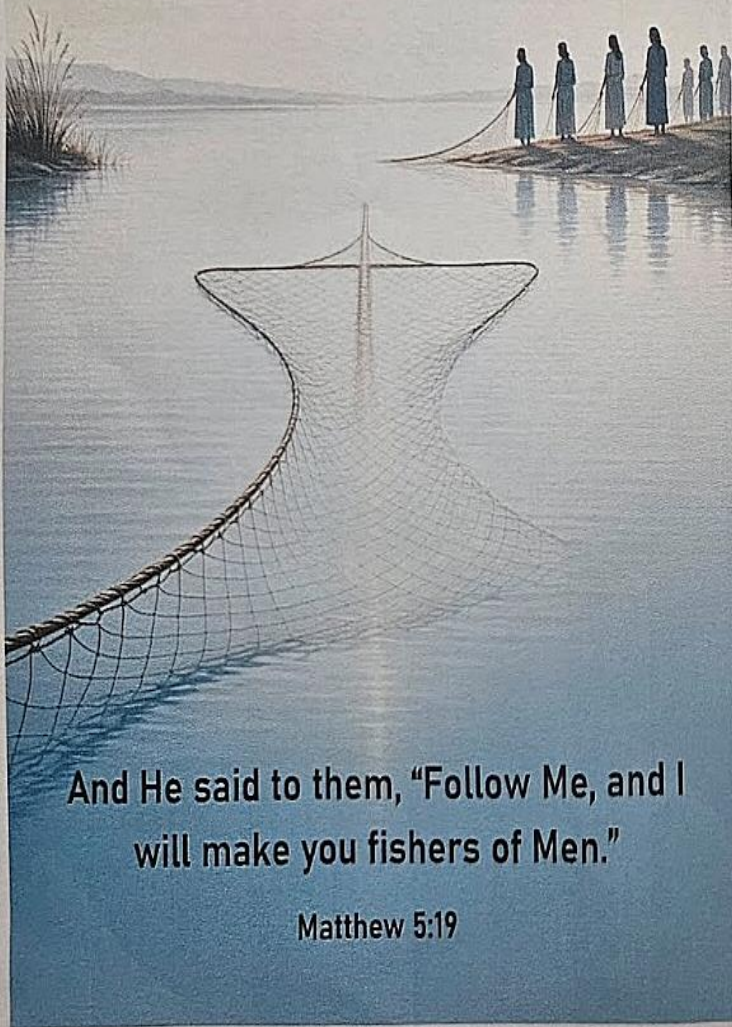
